**Comfort Lake – Forest Lake Watershed District
Watershed Management Plan update
TAC/CAC Stakeholder Meeting**

The Comfort Lake - Forest Lake Watershed District (CLFLWD) currently operates under a 2001 Watershed Management Plan (Plan) that was amended in 2008. The original Plan served the District well during its formative years, but the District has evolved to a point where a completely revised Plan not only is needed, but is required by State Statute. For this reason, the District has recently initiated the process to update its Plan by late-2011. As part of this process, the District Managers are looking to actively engage its Technical and Citizen Advisory Committees (TAC/CAC) throughout to provide input on:

- Watershed health and assessment
- Mission, vision, and issue identification
- Goals, policies, and communication strategies
- Implementation efforts
- Partnerships and coordination

The CLFLWD Managers invite you to attend a meeting on **Wednesday, May 19th at 1:00 p.m., at the Forest Lake City Council Chambers, 220 North Lake Street, Forest Lake, MN.** This is the first of an estimated five meetings of the TAC/CAC stakeholder's group throughout the District's Plan update process.
