Subject: New Manager and Officer Positions



Background/Discussion:

Manager Loth's term will end on September 23rd, and Manager Schottmuller's term will begin September 24th. Manager Loth currently holds the Vice President position on the board. The Board may wish to revisit officer positions at the September 25th regular board meeting to replace the Vice President position and/or consider other officer position changes.

Slate: A slate of candidates may be proposed. This would require a motion, second, and vote to elect the entire slate. This can be done if all managers agree with the entire slate.

Office-by-Office: Officers may be elected individually. This occurs if any manager opposes the slate and requests to proceed with the election office-by-office. The President requests nominations for the offices. A manager may nominate themselves or another manager. Nominations do not require a second. A manager may accept or decline a nomination. Once all nominations have been offered for a given office, an open vote is held. The Board may elect offices in one of the following orders:
