Subject: 2026 Budget & Levy



Background/Discussion

The purpose of this agenda item is to adopt the 2026 budget and direct certification of the levy. The District will hold a duly noticed public hearing on September 25th and accept comments from the public on the proposed budget and levy.

The levy must be certified to Washington County and Chisago County auditors by September 30th. The District will offer another public comment opportunity at its regular board meeting on December 18th. The Board of Managers may not increase, but may reduce the District levy by re-certifying the levy on or before December 26th.

The total proposed expense budget for 2026 is \$4,424,067. The Board proposes a levy ranging from \$2,167,012 to \$2,233,828.
