Subject: Forest Lake Alum Treatment Project Closeout



Background/Discussion

The purpose of this agenda item is to accept the District Engineer's certificate of completion and to close out the Forest Lake Alum Treatment Project.

The District completed the first application of the split-dose treatment in 2023, then monitored treatment effectiveness in 2024. The District adjusted the alum dosage and completed the second split-dose treatment in October 2025. The District Engineer, Emmons & Olivier Resources (EOR), has reviewed the treatment contractor's reports and post-treatment monitoring data and has concluded that the treatment was completed as designed.

The alum treatment bids came in under budget, while engineering and outreach efforts were expended beyond the original budgets to maximize use of overall funds. Staff have also tracked and reported as many eligible match expenditures as possible to maximize the District's use of the grant. Accounting for all the changes in expenditures, the overall project came in under budget by \$18,000.

This project results in an estimated 527 lb/yr phosphorus reduction for Forest Lake, marking a significant milestone in the improvement of Forest Lake. This project has cost-benefit of \$120 per pound of phosphorus removed over the project's 10-year lifespan.
